Barnyard & Historic Park Interpreter/Presenter (part-time)

Position Summary

Serve as a Historic Park and Barnyard Interpreter, interpreting life in the 1800's.

Position Responsibilities

Duties include feeding and handling of large animals, mucking, cleaning, and presenting information about animals, historic skills and our historic houses to the public. Duties will also include presenting for school field trips and other groups. Experience working with large animals and experience interacting with the public is preferred. Knowledge of historic skills is beneficial but may be learned on the job. Ability to do minor maintenance work is helpful. Applicants must be able to lift 50 pounds and climb fences. Work is mainly outdoors in all weather conditions. This position requires wearing of historic-style clothes. Burritt will help you acquire appropriate clothing. Pay is \$10 per hour.

Hours and Compensation

This position requires 7 to 15 hours a week on a regular basis. Weekend and holiday work is required, in addition to weekdays. Applicants must be 19 years of age or older.
